PUBLIC COMMENT – RULES

1. All persons are asked to state their name and address for the record.
2. All comments are to be directed to the Chair of the Wexford Joint Planning Commission, or the 'commission' as a whole, and **not** to individual members.
3. No person shall be permitted to speak more than once on the same matter, excluding time needed to answer 'commission member' questions.
4. Speaking time shall be limited to three (3) minutes per person. Additional time may be granted by the Chair if a group of persons decide to select an individual representative to speak for a group.
5. Please try to refrain from repeating / restating what has already been heard by the commission so that the commission can receive as much 'new' commentary as possible.
6. In order to avoid unnecessary debate, the 'commission' generally will not respond to public comment.

Silence or non-response by the 'commission' should not be interpreted as disinterest or disagreement by the 'commission'.
