AN ORDINANCE TO PARTIALLY REPEAL THE WEXFORD JOINT ZONING ORDINANCE WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF GREENWOOD TOWNSHIP, AMEND THE WEXFORD JOINT ZONING ORDINANCE EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 31, 2016 BY REMOVING GREENWOOD TOWNSHIP AS A PARTICIPATING MUNICIPALITY FROM THE SCOPE OF THE WEXFORD JOINT ZONING ORDINANCE FOLLOWING GREENWOOD TOWNSHIP’S WITHDRAWAL FROM THE WEXFORD JOINT PLANNING COMMISSION, AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

THE TOWNSHIP OF _____ ORDAINS:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to remove Greenwood Township as a Participating Municipality from the Wexford Joint Zoning Ordinance, thereby making it an unzoned township, following Greenwood Township’s withdrawal from the Wexford Joint Planning Commission.

Section 2. Partial Repeal of Wexford Joint Zoning Ordinance. The Wexford Joint Zoning Ordinance, as amended, is hereby repealed within the corporate and jurisdictional limits of Greenwood Township, Wexford County, Michigan.

Section 3. Amend Section 1809. Section 1809 of the Wexford Joint Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the Greenwood Township zoning map.

Section 4. Amend Table of Contents. The Table of Contents of the Wexford Joint Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to delete reference to the “Representation of Greenwood Township Zoning Map” under Article 18, Section 1809.

Section 5. Repealer. All ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective on the eighth day following its publication by the last Participating Municipality to publish it.
