



BUDGET CALCULATIONS

- Each participating municipality shall be responsible for providing its proportional operating funds for the <u>Municipal Budget</u> (**MB**) part of the operation in set out in the following formula. Data for taxable value and number of parcels shall be based upon the most recent data from the Wexford County Equalization Department during January-February when the proposed budget is prepared.
 - (a) Twenty percent of the <u>Municipal Budget</u> (MB) part shall be an equal amount paid by each participating municipality (20% of <u>Municipal Budget</u> (MB) part divided by the number of participating <u>Municipalities</u> (M).
 - (b). Forty percent of the <u>Municipal Budget</u> (MB) part shall be <u>Proportional to the number of Parcels</u> (PP) in each participating municipality. In the case of a township with an incorporated village, the total number of parcels shall not include parcels within the incorporated village within that township.
 - (c). Forty percent of the <u>Municipal Budget</u> (MB) part shall be <u>Proportional to the Taxable Value</u> (PTV) of each participating municipality. In the case of a township with an incorporated village, the Taxable Value shall not include Taxable Value of the incorporated village within that township.

ANNUAL REPORT SUMMARY

IN-THE-PAST

The WJPC has spent the past several years reacting to the more immediate needs of the participating municipalities by amending and updating the master plan, making several ordinance amendments to facilitate certain administrative reviews.

The **WJPC** has been provided information on <u>zoning reform</u> <u>and housing</u>.

BUDGET

The WJPC operates on a minimal cost-share plus fees type budget. The participating municipalities contribute \$50,000 annually, and fees generate an average of \$16,300. Staff dedicates approximately 24 FTE's / week and represents approximately 46% of the budget.

The 24/25 budget reflects priorities associated with the future GOALS.

FUTURE GOALS

The WJPC plans to leverage the Rural Readiness grant AND the human resources available to take a proactive position in addressing housing through zoning.
