Rules for Public Comment and Participation

All meetings of the Wexford Joint Planning Commission are open to the public, and public comment is encouraged and accepted at the appropriate times as listed on the agenda. If a public hearing is scheduled during this meeting, one additional time for public comment will be offered during the public hearing.

Meetings of the Wexford Joint Planning Commission are 'business' meetings - they are not townhall style meetings. The Commission must conduct its business in an organized manner. The PUBLIC are our guests and may only participate where invited.

1. Each comment to the commission made by an individual shall be limited to three (3) minutes.
2. No individual shall be permitted to speak more than once during a session of public comment.
3. Groups of individuals are asked to caucus to select a representative who will be permitted to speak for five (five) minutes. (*time may be extended for 5 additional minutes at the discretion of the Chair*)
4. All comments shall be addressed to the chair; no person may address or question commission members or members of the audience individually.
5. The commission chair shall make an effort to solicit and alternate between supporting and opposing viewpoints on any topic.
6. Although Commission members will generally refrain from answering questions, staff will note questions and input from the public to provide responses at a later date if appropriate.
